

# **Easy Cotton Washcloths**

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### <u>Materials</u>

- 100% cotton yarn #5 bulky (I used Yarn Bee Feelin' Chunky) 3.5oz, 75 yds, or any worsted weight cotton yarn of choice
- 5.5mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- Stitch counter (optional)

### **Abbreviations**

ch- chain dc- double crochet sl st- slip stitch st(s)- stitch(es)

## <u>Pattern</u>

We will be crocheting in rows Start with a slip knot and chain 38

**Row1** Skip the first two ch(s) from the hook and dc in the remaining 36sts.

Ch 2 and turn for each row

**Row2-18** Repeat row 1, 17 more times.

SI st in the last st, fasten off, and weave in ends.

#### Note

You can adjust this pattern if you feel like your gauge is off, simply by adding or decreasing the number of rows. The goal is to make your washcloth as uniform as possible.

You may also choose to block your washcloth for a flatter finished edge.
