



Kawaii Sprouted Pot

This adorable little *Kawaii Sprouted Pot* pattern is a great beginner-friendly project that is fun and easy to whip up. This pattern is great by itself or as a bag charm for any green thumb enthusiast.

MEASUREMENTS

Finished Size-about 2 inches for the pot

MATERIALS

Yarn- I love this cotton; 3 oz/85 g skein; 153 yd/140m (Cotton) #4

Color Palette- (A) *Antique gold*, (B) *Brown*, (C) *Sage*

Hook- 3.5 mm

Other-Yarn needles, Scissors, Poly-fil stuffing, 2- 10 mm safety eyes, black & pink embroidery thread, and 1" round thin cardboard.

ABBREVIATION/SYMBOLS

blo: back loop only

flo: front loop only

Inc: increase (an increase is made by placing two single crochets into one stitch)

rep: repeat

rnd: round(s)

sc: single crochet

slst: slip stitch

st(s): stitch(es)

[] Work within the brackets a specified number of times

NOTES

1. This pattern is worked up in three steps: the pot, soil, and rim of the pot.
2. The sprout is done using the latch hook method. You'll latch hook three strands of yarn (C) into the center of the adjustable ring of the soil (B) section.
3. The soil (B) and the pot (A) are sewn together using the whip stitch method and sewn into the back loop of yarn (A).

SPECIAL STITCH(ES)

Whipstitch- In which the needle is passed in and out of the stitches in a sequence of stitches that circle an edge of the stitches.

PATTERN- POT (A)

Place 6 sc into an adjustable ring (6 sts)

Rnd 2: [Inc] 6x (12 sts)

Rnd 3: [Inc, 1 sc] 6x (18 sts)

Rnd 4: [Inc, 2 sc] 6x (24 sts)

Rnd 5: sc in blo of all 24 sts

Rnd 6-8: sc in each st around

Place safety eyes between rnds 8 & 9, about 3-4 sts apart.



Rnd 9: [Inc, 3 sc] 6x (30 sts)

Rnd 10-11: sc in each st around

Fasten off, and hide the yarn tail inside the pot.



Hide the raming yarn inside the pot by pulling it through the next stitch.

SOIL (B)

Place 6 sc into an adjustable ring (6 sts)

Rnd 2: [Inc] 6x (12 sts)

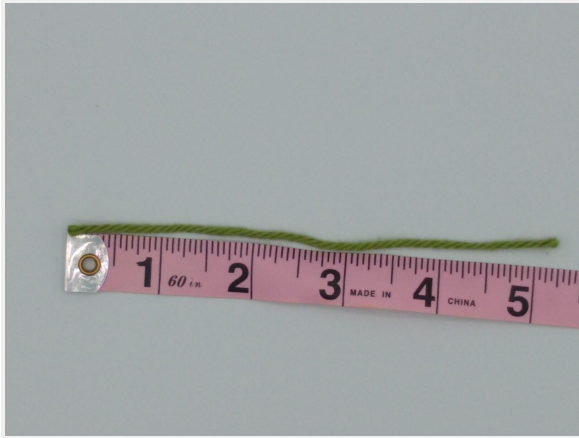
Rnd 3: [Inc, 1 sc] 6x (18 sts)

Rnd 4: [Inc, 2 sc] 6x (24 sts)

Rnd 5: [Inc, 3 sc] 6x (30 sts)

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

SPROUT (C)



Cut 3- strands of yarn (C) about 5 ½ " in length.



Pull up the strand to tighten the loop.

SEWING



Insert your hook into the center of the ring, fold your strands in half, and pull through the stitch, pulling up a loop.



Begin to stuff the pot with your needle and the tail from yarn (B), and whip stitch into the BLO of the pot (A).



With your hook, pull the remaining strands through the loop on your hook.



Before closing, continue to stuff the pot until firm. Sew close and weave in & cut yarn end.

RIM OF POT



Re-attach yarn (A) to the FLO of round 11,

Rnd 11: Sc in the FLO (30 sts)

Rnd 12: Sc in each st around



FINISHING TOUCHES



Cut the sprout strands, leaving about an inch in length. Separate the strands to give it a fuller effect.

With your black embroidery thread, sew a little V smile in the center of the eyes, one round down.

With the pink thread, sew to a little pink cheek near the corner of the eyes about 1 to 2 sts in length.
